



Registration Requirements For Observers



OBSERVER ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be affiliated with a team that **has already been verified and confirmed** as an official competition participant.
- Applications submitted without an affiliated and verified team shall not be accepted.
- Applicants must be faculty members or institutional personnel affiliated with the same institution or faculty as the registered team at the time of application and competition.
- Each team is permitted to **register no more than 1 observer**.



OBSERVER ROLE & RESTRICTIONS:

- Observers are permitted to attend and observe all competition rounds, including the MCQ Preliminary Round, Quarterfinal, Resurrection, Semifinal, and Final rounds, as well as participate in all official non-competitive activities such as cultural workshop and the Chiang Mai tour.
- Observers are not permitted to participate in any competition rounds as competitors.

Registration Requirements For Observers (cont.)



CAPACITY:

- The total number of observers is limited to a **maximum of 10 participants.**
- Slots are allocated on a **first-paid, first-confirmed basis**, according to the system record.



APPLICATION FEE:

- The application fee is **12,000 THB per person.**



THE APPLICATION FEE INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- **4-night accommodation** (17–21 December 2026), arranged together with the affiliated team (3 competitors, 1 advisor, and 1 observer)
 - The observer will be assigned to a twin-share room together with a same-gender member of their affiliated team – preferably the team's advisor, or otherwise one of the competitors. Final room assignments are made by the organizing committee after registration closes
- **Meals and snacks** during the competition and tour program (18–20 December 2026)
- **Souvenirs**
- **Chiang Mai tour** excursion
- **Cultural workshop** activities
- Special activities
